



## E-mail from the National Registry

Did you get one of these?

Hi \_\_\_\_\_,

You are a registered responder for \_\_\_\_\_ AED located in Durango. To provide the best possible chance of survival for victims of Cardiac Arrest you are listed to receive an automated phone and/or text alert to \_\_\_\_\_ from your local 9-1-1 service to respond with your AED. If this is not the correct number please update your information or contact us for assistance.

In order for us to improve outcomes we urge you to take the following steps so that you will recognize the alerts when they are sent to you.

Create 503-822-6774 as a contact in your smartphone ...

This recent e-mail was sent by the team at the National Registry to all our responders. While it is good to check the continued willingness of people to respond, we at Heart Safe La Plata were not aware this was being sent. If you replied to this e-mail or called the National Registry team, you still need to let us know directly if there are any changes to your responders.

## Have You Received an AED Link Call?

The system is working! When dispatch recognizes a cardiac arrest has occurred, the AED Link software activates all of the AEDs within a 1200 foot radius of the event. If there is not an AED within 1200 feet, it will call the nearest AED. For the downtown area, we are finding that multiple AEDs are being dispatched. Please do not assume that someone else will handle the call. Your delivery of the AED could save a life. However, if it would take you more than 5 minutes to deliver the AED, then the local fire department will probably get there first.

So we are asking you to use some common sense. There are lots of reasons that you cannot or should not respond. It could be after work hours or you might not be in the building where the AED is located. It would help dispatch if they knew whether or not you are going. So please respond to the text with "OK" or "NA." For a voice message, use 4 if you are going and 6 if you are not.

Please do not go to a private residence of someone you do not know without EMS or Police escort. There is no way for the dispatcher to let you know what kind of a scene is there.

There have been some calls where the AED is located across the river from the scene. We do not expect you to jump in your car to take the AED to a scene. Most of the time you should be able to walk it to the event location. The exception to this is in some of our rural subdivisions where response time from town is long enough that you might need to grab the AED and take it to your neighbor's house.

There have been a few calls where multiple AEDs have been delivered to the scene. Please do not feel like this is a waste of your time. You were making an effort to help save a life. That is no small thing. We do not want to waste your time but we also want to save that life if we can.

Right now we have all sites registered to get notices 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Therefore, you might get a call when you are not available. Do not worry about not being able to respond. Just respond when you can.
