G2015 CPR & Basic First Aid

The long-awaited new ASHI materials from the 2015 Guidelines summit released in June. We have ordered the updated materials and will be able to fill you in on some of the changes soon. Here are a few interesting ones:

- Use of feedback devices can be effective in improving CPR performance during training
- Administration of naloxone to all unresponsive opioid associated life- threatening emergency patients
- Perform CPR with the goal of a chest compression fraction as high as possible, with a target of at least 60%
- In remote or wilderness settings where commercially made topical antibiotics are not available, it may be reasonable to consider applying honey topically as an antimicrobial agent
